- Established a Graduation Specialist Support Committee
- Evaluated, revised training, and job description of Registrars and Counselors
- Identification of specific students in 4 and 5 year cohort and development of procedures for monitoring records is in progress
- Training, monitoring and supporting schools with data and permanent records and cohort entry data is in progress
- Audit of permanent records to ensure accurate documentation collected at schools is in progress
- Development of system-wide registration, data records collection/retention/transfer process is in progress
- Formed districtwide RTI committee
- Schools identified specific students in need of tiered interventions and provided appropriate interventions

## DO

Describe the work of your team in achieving your performance objectives. Specifically address your initiatives and action steps.

- Trained the RtI Teams from each school in the RtI process
- Trained Rtl Teams in the use of the district's universal screener to identify students in need of intervention
- Graduation specialist committee has commenced with developing graduation protocols and plans, including standard operating procedures for graduating senior transcript audit and development of protocols for monitoring 4 and 5-year cohort development and record keeping procedures.

## CHECK

Are you getting the results needed to reach the performance targets? How are you monitoring and measuring to ensure results?

• High school graduation rates increased approximately 8 percentage points this year. This was due, in part, to focused efforts in student transcript auditing and wrap-around services relative to providing added support to underrepresented students to help them complete high school within a 4-year cohort.
