GaDOE Celebrates Several DCSD Title 1 Schools for Significant Academic Achievement and Improvement

(STONE MOUNTAIN, GA) – On October 2, the Georgia Department of Education (*GaDOE*) released the 2022-2023 lists of *Distinguished* and *Reward Schools*, spotlighting many from the DeKalb County School District (*DCSD*). The *Distinguished Schools* designation recognizes the highest-performing Title I schools in Georgia, while the *Reward Schools* designation recognizes Title I schools making the most significant improvements.

Superintendent Dr. Devon Horton praised the DCSD schools that are persevering and succeeding to earn these well-deserved recognitions.
