DRSEF Webpage: All students, sponsors, and parents are required to observe the DRSEF Overview Module and complete the DRSEF Checklist.

Novice Division (Elementary) – Maximum of four project entries. Grades 3-5 are eliaible

Timeline of Important Dates

- August 22, 2024: Science Representatives' and Science Department Chairpersons' DRSEF learning opportunity.
- August 22, 2024- September 30, 2024: Obtain administrative approval for participation, and school fair procedures and important dates.
 - Complete the intent to participate Form
 - Inform students and parents about the science & engineering fair, review safety and guidance procedures with participants and view safety module.
 - o Develop a Fair Committee to support conducting the school science & engineering fair
 - Begin to recruit expert judges for the school science & engineering fair
- September 30- October 11, 2024: Teachers collect all required DRSEF paperwork for each project. Teacher reviews paperwork for completeness; approves standard projects; submits others to Scientific Review Committee (SRC) or Institutional Review Board (IRB). No experimentation can start until projects (s) are approved. All projects requiring an SRC or IRB committee must be approved before experimentation.
- October 21- October 30, 2024: Suggested: Deadline for approval of all SRC/IRB Paperwork at the local school site. Projects can proceed after approved.

- **December 2-6, 2024:** Suggested *: FINAL RESEARCH REPORT is due to the local school teacher/sponsor- all experimentation should be complete by this time.
- December 2-6, 2024: Suggested: Final Poster/Display Presentation due to the local school teacher/ sponsor
- December 13, 2024: Suggested LAST DAY to hold a school-based fair.
- **December 16, 2024:** All paperwork and files for projects entering the 2024-2025 DeKalb Regional Science and Engineering Fair are due for upload. **Please Note**: The deadline <u>will not</u> be extended.
- DRSEF set-up will be held January 31-February 1, 2025 for Novice division.
- Setup & Competition for Novice Division: January 31, 2025 from 4:00 p.m.- 6:30p.m.
- Setup for Junior & Senior Division: Friday, January 31, 2025 from 4:00pm.- 7:00p.m.
- Junior & Senior Division Competition: Saturday, February 1, 2025 from 8:00am.-12:00p.m.

The 77th Georgia Science & Engineering Fair will be held April 3-5, 2025 at The Classic Center in downtown Athens, Georgia. Researchers in grades 6-12 may qualify for GSEF by advancing from a school level fair to one of the GSEF-Affiliated Regional Fairs across the state, where they may be selected to compete in Athens this spring.

The Regeneron International Science and Engineering Fair takes place May 10th – 16th, 2025 – Columbus, Ohio. *Traveling expenses associated with the state and international fair are the responsibilities of the parent/guardians.*
